## How the Weekly Challenge works

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Every week, we introduce a new themed challenge to inspire our members to share their best wildlife and nature photography. These themes cover a wide range of topics, from birds and mammals to reptiles, insects, landscapes, and creative compositions in nature. The goal is to keep things exciting, challenge you to explore different aspects of photography, and provide a space for everyone to showcase their unique perspectives.



For example, in a past challenge, we have focused on themes like, "Hidden in Plain Sight", encouraged photographers to capture well-camouflaged creatures blending into their surroundings.

Another theme could be "Nature's Clean-Up Crew" and would focus on the often-overlooked but vital scavengers and decomposers in the wild—vultures, hyenas, dung beetles, and more.

Your challenge would be to capture these species in action, highlighting their role in maintaining the balance of nature.

- Keep images nature and wildlife-related—no domestic animals.
- One image per member per challenge—choose your best!
- Images must be your own work—no sharing from others.
